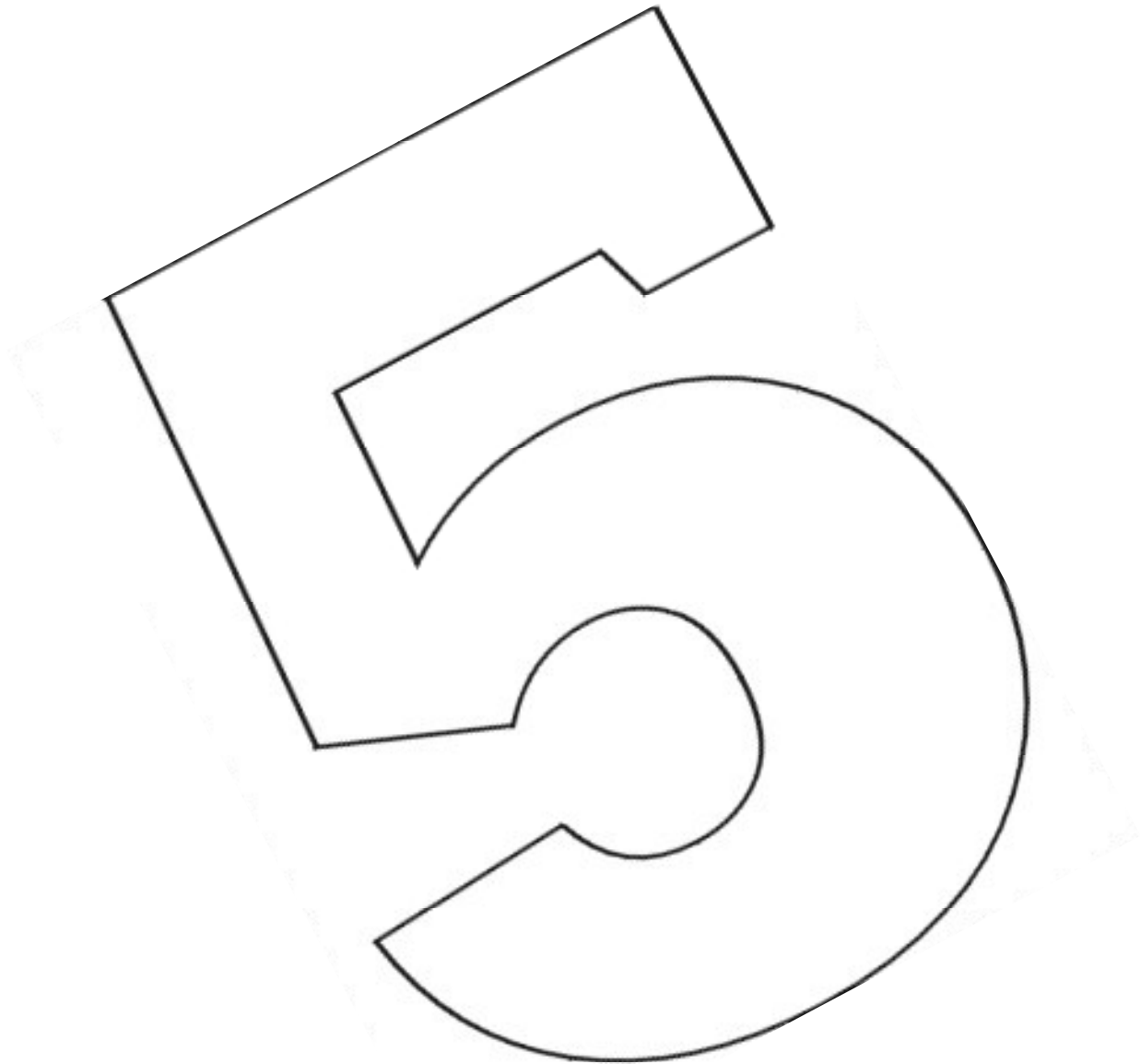

## Letter from the Chairman & Executive Director

In January of 2009 the Tower Theatre Foundation celebrated the fifth anniversary of the rebirth of one of Central Oregon’s most important cultural and community icons. So much more than a building, the Tower Theatre has become a real community gathering place, an embodiment of everything that makes this not just somewhere to live, but somewhere to call home.

Every year since its re-opening the Tower had been increasingly successful. In the beginning it ran at a deficit—which was planned for. In each subsequent year the deficit was whittled down—from \$57,000 in 2006 to \$18,500 in 2007 to a surplus of nearly \$10,000 in 2008.

This occurred while staying true to its vision of being a venue and service where local organizations of all kinds could find a home. In 2008-2009 the theater was open to more than 185 local users, from the High Desert Art League, The Nature of Words and Amity Creek Magnet School to the Deschutes Public Library, the Oregon Bach Festival and youth theater groups. To meet the cultural needs of the region, the Foundation produced annual series and individual events featuring locally and nationally acclaimed performing artists--“Sold Out” wasn’t uncommon.

In 2008/09 thirty-eight thousand people attended performances at the Tower; 1,700 volunteer hours were donated to the Foundation; 29 local businesses offered gifts and services from marketing and advertising to printing.

In just five years the theater went from a derelict building to full membership in a thriving community. Skillful programming, attention to costs, solid fund raising, and gradual acceptance by the community put the theater on a par with any other of its kind.

While we have enjoyed tremendous support and success in our first five years, the Foundation has not been immune to the precipitous economic decline that has colored almost every aspect of our community. In our 2008/09 fiscal year we drew down our operating reserve and must remain sharply focused on ways to increase revenue and ensure that the Foundation has continuing financial stability.

On the operations side the Tower management continues to aggressively contain costs by keeping staff headcount low and overhead minimal. In this lean and efficient mode, the Foundation intends to create a strategic plan for the next 2-5 years, reflecting nominal growth and continued conservative budgets.

On behalf of the board of directors, staff, donors, sponsors, members, volunteers and members of the Central Oregon community we remain steadfastly committed to ensuring that the Tower remains active and vital through increased rentals and creative—yet financially viable—partnerships with local nonprofits, national promoters, and regional tourism organizations. Theatre leadership will vigorously seek grants and new sources of contributed income to deepen reserves and further

## TOWER THEATRE HISTORY

The Tower Theatre was built in 1940 as a movie house. Since then, the Tower's 70 foot sign has stood tall above the heart of downtown Bend, a witness to changing styles and times. During most of its life, the theatre served as a motion picture venue with occasional staging of local entertainments and events.

Having fallen victim to the advent and popularity of television and later to multiplex theatres, the Tower suffered from slow deterioration and lack of attention, finally closing its glass-paneled doors in the mid-1990s. Community leaders and grass roots organizations saw the need and potential for a performing arts center and to that end they became increasingly dedicated. The result was a groundswell of support that culminated in a \$4.2 million renovation that completely restructured and redesigned the original floor plan and is now a state-of-the-art entertainment facility.

The Tower Theatre now accommodates 465 patrons in luxurious comfort, which is enhanced by the finest in lighting, sound and a constantly monitored and controlled atmosphere. The rich appointments in this Art Deco Moderne theatre evoke a time when enjoyment of live performances was something to be savored like fine wine.

As a designated not-for-profit, 501(c)3 corporation under Federal Law, the Tower Theatre Foundation provides a variety of entertainment and enrichment programs while making the facility available for use by nonprofit organizations and businesses. The staff of full- and part-time employees is supported by more than 100 volunteers whose overriding goal is continued quality service to patrons and theatre renters.

## TOWER THEATRE FOUNDATION PROGRAMS

The Tower Theatre Foundation maintains, coordinates and presents several programs throughout the year. The two major series are: Francis Hansen & Martin's CenterStage and the Bend Surgery Center's Foundation Series. Each series has its own coordination, booking and promotional elements and each caters to a variety of community demographics.

**CenterStage Series** is a premiere live entertainment series featuring intimate, solo concerts and small group performances by top entertainers. The inaugural 2009-10 Series promises an electrifying selection of artists including Ed Asner as FDR, Rita Coolidge, Suzanne Vega, The Irish Rovers and Betty Buckley. With the strongest pre-season sales in the Foundation's history, the first performance in the series was sold out, setting the bar high for the rest of the CenterStage series.

**The Foundation Series** is a multicultural, international series that, literally, brings the world to Bend. Past shows in the Foundation Series have included Defending the Caveman, BodyVox and International Guitar Night. Attendance figures have grown steadily and sold-out houses again have been the rule, not the exception. For the upcoming 2009-10 season a stellar list of talent has been arranged: The Art of Bellydance; Tiempo Libre; The Peking Acrobats; Vienna Boys Choir; and Lakota Sioux Theatre.

**A CHRISTMAS CAROL** – In December 2009 we again celebrate the holidays with six public performances and two daytime shows especially for school children of the second annual Charles Dickens’ “A Christmas Carol,” adapted by and presented in partnership with Bend Experimental Arts Theatre (B.E.A.T.).

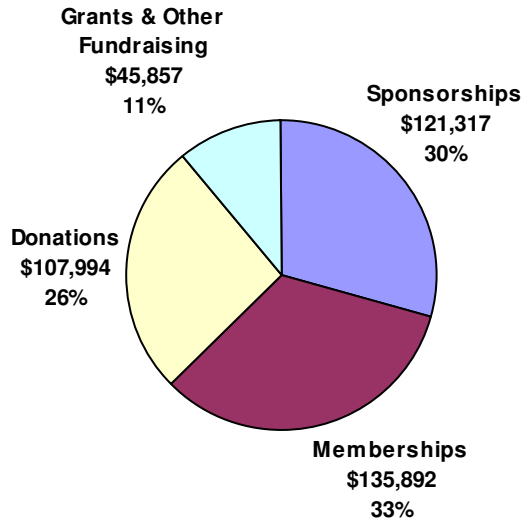

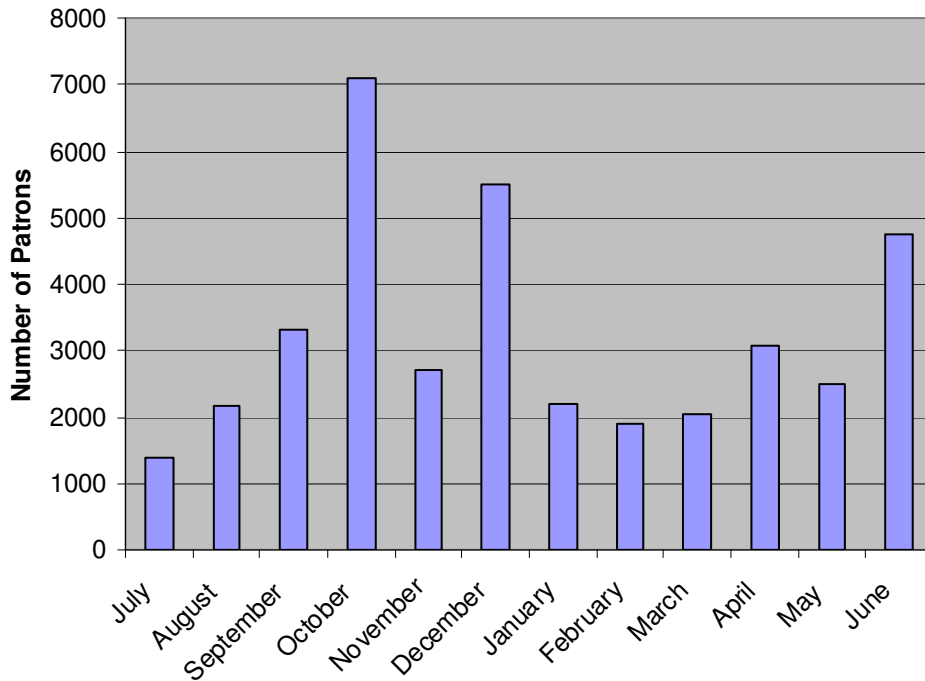
